INSTRUTIONS TO STUDENTS

For the 4th year B.Tech. students of GRIET, the final theory examinations will be held from 16-09-20 onwards. The following message is issued for the guidance of students who have chosen GRIET as the centre for these examinations

- 1. VEHICLES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE CAMPUS. Kindly cooperate with security to park your vehicles outside the main gate.
- 2. WEARING OF FACE MASK AND ID CARD IS COMPULSORY. No face mask, no entry into campus.
- 3. Kindly cooperate with staff to record temperature and to sanitize hands at the Main Gate, while maintaining social distance. Adequate arrangements have been made at the main gate of GRIET for hand sanitization and temperature recording of students.
- 4. If any student is unable to attend the IV B.Tech. II semester exams due to mobility restrictions caused by corona pandemic, such students can appear for the advanced supply exams which shall be scheduled within two months after the conduct of regular B.Tech. II semester exams. It will be not treated as supplementary exams for those students who do not appear for even a single exam.
- 5. Parking, Sanitization and temperature checking is likely to take some time. Hence, students are advised to reach the college one hour before the starting time of examination.
- 6. In view of COVID19, college canteen is closed. Hence, students are advised to bring their own water bottles and snacks.
- 7. The seating plan for the examinations will be made available online to students in the next few days.
- 8. Students are advised to maintain strict social distance while inside the campus. They should not form groups on completion of examination. They should also leave the campus as soon as examination is over.
- 9. Hall ticket will be handed over to students in the examination hall.

10. Family members of students will not be allowed inside the campus.

11. After completion of examination, all the students will not be allowed to leave the examination hall at the same time. To ensure social distancing, students will be allowed to leave the examination halls in a staggered manner. So the students should follow the instructions of invigilator in this regard.
